<b>Brief description of the institution</b>	The FIDMAG Research Foundation works to improve the understanding and the treatment of major mental illnesses through basic and clinical research, paving the way for prevention, recovery and cure. FIDMAG's main interest is in the field of psychosis, with particular expertise in the area of neuroimaging and genetics.		
<b>Brief description of the Group</b>	FIDMAG consists of a core team of 17 individuals dedicated exclusively to research, who work in collaboration with a broader group of psychiatrists, clinical psychologists and health professionals in the Hermanas Hospitalarias network of hospitals in Spain. We also maintain collaborations with other institutions and universities, both nationally and internationally.		
<b>Brief description of the Project</b>	<p>The focus of our work is the investigation of severe mental disorders, specifically schizophrenia and bipolar disorder. We study:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The relationship between genetic factors, neurobiological and neurodevelopmental phenotypes. For this, we employ a range of state-of-the-art genetic and epigenetic methodologies following both candidate gene and whole-genome approaches in family-based and case-control designs.</li> <li>- The structural and functional imaging changes in severe mental disorders, and the relationship of such changes to symptoms and cognition. For this we employ a range of state-of-the-art structural and functional imaging methodologies and techniques.</li> </ul>		
<b>Who can apply?</b>	<p>At the deadline for the submission of MSCA proposals (12/10/2021), the researcher:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- will be in possession of a doctoral degree or have at least four years of full-time equivalent research experience.</li> <li>- must not have resided or carried out his/her main activities in Spain for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the abovementioned deadline.</li> </ul>
